The Rights Alliance provides employees at educational institutions with answers to questions that may arise when using textbooks and other copyrighted material in chatbots

**Is it allowed to upload textbooks or excerpts to ChatGPT or other chatbots?**

**No, you cannot\***

**Can I upload textbooks or excerpts of textbooks to a customized Chatbot such as OpenAI's "GPTs", which are not shared with others and are for my own use only?**

**No, you cannot\***

**Is it allowed to upload textbooks or excerpts of textbooks to a customized Chatbot such as OpenAI's "GPTs" that are not shared with others and then share the chatbot with others?**

**No, you cannot\***

**Is it allowed to upload textbooks or excerpts of textbooks to a generative AI tool for the purpose of generating an audiobook version of the textbook?'**

**No, you cannot\***

**Do the agreements with Copydan Text & Node cover the use of textbooks in relation to ChatGPT or other generative AI tools?**

**No, the agreements do not cover the use of textbooks in the context of generative AI tools**
